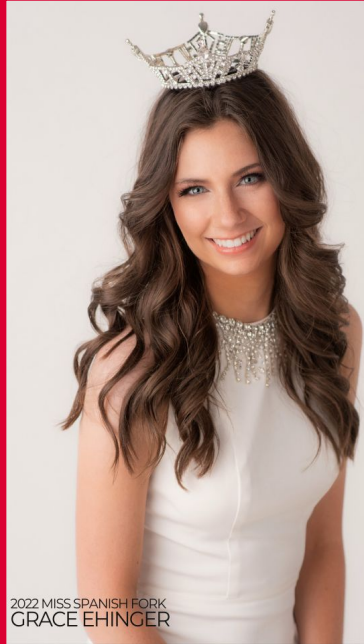

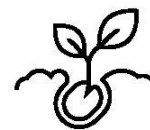
Arbor Day Tree Planting

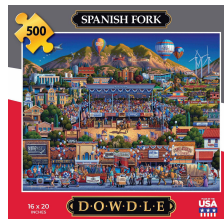
