This year, each residence will get 3 free spring cleanup vouchers to the new indoor transfer station. **These vouchers will only be good during Spring Cleanup from April 29–May 11.** The vouchers are taking the place of dumpsters in City parks this year.

Transfer station hours are Monday–Saturday 7 a.m. to 6 p.m.

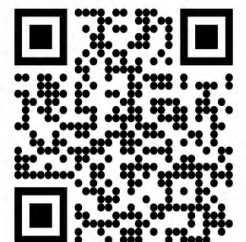

US-6 Construction Update

UDOT will continue excavation work and placing road base materials along the eastbound shoulder between I-15 and Canyon Creek Parkway. This construction creates safer shoulders for both traffic and workers.

UDOT will also continue working in approximately 400-foot sections in the project area to help maintain and improve traffic flow.

Nightly work is Sunday through Thursday nights from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

UDOT will be conducting maintenance work on US-6 near the convergence of US-89, closer to the mouth of Spanish Fork Canyon. This is expected to last approximately two weeks.
