UDOT is constructing a new I-15 interchange at 1600 S / 2700 N and widening the road from Main Street in Spanish Fork to the Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) Tintic Line in Springville. Construction is anticipated to be completed late 2026 and will include:

- New I-15 interchange
- Road widened to two lanes from Main St. in Spanish Fork to the UPRR Tintic Line in Springville
- Shared-use path on the north side of widened road
- Bridge over the UPRR Sharp Line
- Utility relocations east of the UPRR Tintic Line

### **Pressurized Irrigation Shut-off**

Once the system is shut down in mid-October, please be sure to turn off your sprinkler system. This will prevent unintended flooding in spring.

In order to turn off your sprinkler system, open the green pressurized irrigation box that is located near the sidewalk. Turn the valve in the box perpendicular to the pipe.

It is also a good idea to take the time to unhook your hose from your outside water faucet. This keeps freezing water from bursting the pipes coming from inside your home.

A beloved tradition returns this holiday season with an important change. Due to the popularity of our Festival of Lights event, we have moved to an **advanced ticketing system**. Beginning **November 1**, you will be able to pay for and reserve a time to see the Festival of Lights easily through sfcitytix.com. Reservation times will be in half hour increments during open times, and you will be able to see which times are sold out, filling up quickly, or still have plenty of availability.

If you try to get in without an advanced ticketing time, you will pay an additional booth fee and run the risk of not getting in.
