SINGLE ELIMINATION



All players must be in matching jerseys (color) with appropriate numbers on the back. NO DUPLICATE NUMBERS ALLOWED! Players without a jersey, and players with duplicate numbers will be charged a player and team foul to start a game.

Awards: T-shirts will be presented after the championship game to individual members of the Championship Team.

All players in the Men's Nebo tournament need to be 18 years of age or older. High school players should play in youth leagues.

PLAYING RULES

- 1. Players: Only those players who have been on the team roster during the regular season play are eligible for tournament play. NO PICK-UP PLAYERS ALLOWED! If a team is found to be cheating, the game will be forfeited. Players need to bring ID's in case they are asked to verify their identity.
- 2. A team must have four players to start the game and must still have 4 players by half. On the 6:00 game only, forfeit time will be 6:10. The game clock will start at 6:00pm even if the game is not starting. On all other games, forfeit time is game time.
- 3. Two 18-minute halves will be played with a three-minute half time. A three-minute warm-up time will be allowed before each game.
- 4. The clock will stop on shooting fouls and other violations if the ball is away from the call, otherwise the clock will keep running. Clock will stop the last minute of the first half and the last two minutes of the second half on every whistle if the lead is less than 15 points. If one team is ahead by 15 or more points, the clock will run (unless under 30 seconds), even on free throws.
- 5. Two time-outs per half, no carry-overs will be allowed. One time-out per team will be allowed in overtime. Ball may be taken out at half court after all time-outs.
- 6. One & one will be shot on the 7th team foul. Two shots will be shot on the 10th team foul.
- 7. A player will foul out on his 5th personal foul.
- 8. Overtime: 1st OT 3 minutes, 2nd OT first to score.
- 9. All other High School rules will apply.
- 10. If a player receives a technical foul (conduct related) during a game, he is done for the game and must leave the building. Additionally, if a player receives a technical foul (conduct related) during the 2nd half or after a game, he must sit out for the 1st half of the next game. Any player receiving two technical fouls during the tournament will be done for the tournament. (Regular season technical totals will continue on into the tournament.) All technical fouls are subject to removal from the tournament at the Rec staff's discretion depending on severity.
