

Local Referendum Application:

TO PLACE A CITIZEN'S REFERENDUM TO REPEAL RESOLUTION NO. 22-28

To the Honorable Tara Silver, Spanish Fork City Recorder:

On August 2, 2022, the Spanish Fork City Council adopted Resolution No. 22-28, entitled, A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A TAX RATE FOR THE 2022-2023 FISCAL YEAR.

We, the undersigned citizens of Utah, respectfully order that the decision of the Spanish Fork City Council on August 2, 2022, be referred to a vote of the people for their approval or rejection at the next general election to be held in November 2023, or at an earlier election as allowed by Utah law.

The proposed referendum will ask Spanish Fork City residents to repeal Spanish Fork City Council's enactment of Resolution No. 22-28 adopting and establishing the tax rate of .001111 for tax year 2022 (2023 fiscal year general fund), with the result of not adopting a tax rate above the certified tax rate as calculated by the Utah County Auditor's office.

This application is being filed with the recorder of Spanish Fork City, in accordance with Utah Referendum Code 20A-7-Part 6. It is being submitted by five sponsors of the referendum petition whose names are below and whose signatures pages and certificates are included.

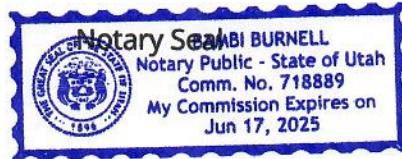

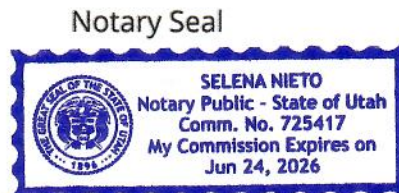

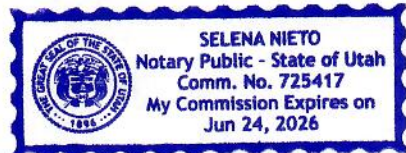

RESOLUTION No. 22-28

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A TAX RATE FOR THE 2022-2023 FISCAL YEAR

WHEREAS Spanish Fork City will adopt its budget for the Fiscal Year 2022-2023, in accordance with law;

WHEREAS the Spanish Fork City Council is required to adopt a tax rate to impose on real property within Spanish Fork;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 59-2-912, the Spanish Fork City Council desires to adopt a tax rate greater than the certified tax rate as calculated by the Utah County Auditor's office but less than the proposed tax rate (0.001111) adopted by the City Council in Resolution 22-21; and

WHEREAS the City Council has provided public notice and conducted a public hearing as set forth by Utah Code Ann. § 59-2-919 and now desires to set a tax rate for Fiscal Year 2022-2023;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SPANISH FORK CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Tax Rate Adopted. The Spanish Fork City Council hereby sets, establishes, and adopts the tax rate of .001111 for tax year 2022 (2023 fiscal year general fund budget).


Section 2. Report to Utah County Auditor. City staff is directed to report the rate and levy and any other required information to the Utah County Auditor, pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 59-2-912.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

NOTICE OF PROPOSED TAX INCREASE
Spanish Fork City

The Spanish Fork City is proposing to increase its property tax revenue.

- The Spanish Fork City tax on a \$461,000 residence would increase from \$222.87 to \$281.69, which is \$58.82 per year.

- The Spanish Fork City tax on a \$461,000 business would increase from \$405.22 to \$512.17, which is \$106.95 per year.

- If the proposed budget is approved, Spanish Fork City would increase its property tax budgeted revenue by 26.41% above last year's property tax budgeted revenue excluding eligible new growth.

All concerned citizens are invited to a public hearing on the tax increase.
