## SNOW PLOWING AND PARKING

City ordinance requires that residents not park anything along the street once snow starts accumulating and during snow plow operations for up to 48 hours after a snowstorm. Benefits of this ordinance include:

- Streets cleared of snow more quickly and thoroughly
- Less incidents of damaged parked vehicles and trailers by plowing operations
- Safer plowing conditions, especially on steep roads
- Nuisance broken down vehicles and trailers will be cleared from the streets regularly

### UTILITY PAYMENT DUE DATE CHANGE

Beginning January 2022 utility payment due dates will be moved from the 20<sup>th</sup> of each month to the 25<sup>th</sup> of each month. The bill due on January 25th should be delivered around January 8th and will be for services provided from November 21st through December 20th.

Customers will have until January 25<sup>th</sup> to pay their bill online, in person, or over the phone. Customers paying through ACH autopay will have their accounts charged on January 25<sup>th</sup>.
